## 1997 Sauvignon Blanc Peterson Vineyard

Winemaking Technique: Our 100% Sauvignon Blanc is from the Peterson Vineyard in Kenwood. A moderate summer with cool nights, brought tropical fruit flavors to the forefront (hints of pear & pineapple). Fermentation entirely in neutral, French oak barrels, produced a rounder, less herbal SB than by using of steel tanks, the usual technique. A combination of three yeasts added distinct characteristics from each to the blend. Malo-lactic fermentation was allowed to proceed halfway, which added mouth feel, fullness, additional layers of complexity and a longer finish. We produced 400 cases.

Tasting Notes: The nose is full and rich with hints of mango and citrus. The taste is smooth in front with layers of tropical fruit, pears, pineapple and just a hint of grapefruit. The overall sensation is mellow and smooth with a mild herb finish. It has none of the wet grass character of steel-fermented SB. Chardonnay lovers and those who don't usually favor SB, will really appreciate this wine. Enjoy it by itself, with white meat, seafood or vegetarian fare.
